Sister Lion had an idea! She could use a game to help get the chores done.




“I will give you clues to find things that are the shape of a rectangle like this door.”

shouted Little Lion.




Both Happy Hippo and Little Lion could fit on the long side of the table but only Bush Baby could fit on the short side.




“The table is clean! One chore is done!”
said Sister Lion.




“Happy Hippo,
