# WHAT IS IT?



When *Fall Guys* released in August 2020 it took the gaming and streaming world by storm. This chaotic party royale game draws inspiration from game shows and playground games and its brightly coloured visuals disguise its difficulty. It sold over 10 million copies at launch and, when it became free-to-play, attracted over 50 million players.



Developed by Mediatonic, the game initially launched on PC and Playstation before being added to Nintendo and Xbox after being acquired by Epic Games with full cross-platform play support among all platforms. This award-winning game is a firm favourite for serious and casual gamers alike and doesn't seem to be going anywhere any time soon.

# BREAKDOWN THE BASICS

The game is simple. Complete each mini-game challenge and move on to the next Round. You're battling it out with fifty-nine other players and did we mention you're bean? Each game is made up of several mini-games that players must complete to qualify for the next Round.

Some of these mini-games involve making it to a finish line at the end of the map, surviving increasingly harsh conditions, or playing tag with other players, or even team challenges. As you progress the mini-games become increasingly challenging with added obstacles and other mechanics. Players who fail to meet the level requirements are eliminated. In the final Round, the few remaining players will face off on a smaller map and the winner takes the crown.

## Mechanics

The mechanics you'll need to master vary from one Round to another. At the start of each Round, instructions appear on-screen that tell you what you need to do in order to complete the Round and qualify for the next. You'll also be shown an overview of the map to give you clues as to what may be in store so pay close attention.

**Obstacles:** There are stationary obstacles that you must navigate, moving obstacles where timing is essential, and interactive objects that must be carried or activated to progress.

**Surfaces:** Floors and other surfaces in the game may be made of various substances that add to the challenge. Water may slow you down, slime is slippery, and sometimes the floor will literally fall away under your feet the moment you touch them. You'll need to channel your inner Indiana Jones to ensure you survive it all.



## Modes

To join the chaos you need to select a Match Mode or Show.

**Solo/Duo/Squads Show:** Compete in a random selection of standard mini-games as one, two, or a squad of four players.

**X-treme Show:** also available for different group sizes, these mini-games are a little more challenging and players will not respawn.


**Seasonal Shows:** a wide variety of seasonal or event Shows become available for limited times. These may feature unique mechanics so be sure to pay attention to the map instructions!



## Round Types

Each match features a random selection of mini-games aka Rounds. There are seven different Categories of Rounds with different aims, mechanics, and sizes:

- **Race:** The most common type of round, here you race through to the finish line.
- **Survival:** All you need to do is stay alive for as long as possible.
- **Hunt:** Find the things! Follow the instructions as there are different things.
- **Team:** Work together to accomplish the Round objective.
- **Logic:** Sometimes brute strength is not enough. Use your brain to solve the puzzle.
- **Invisibeans:** Teams will each be given a different goal to accomplish.
- **Finals:** The Finals decide the ultimate winner so the stakes are high.



# Environment

There are 81 different maps in *Fall Guys*. They vary in size, type, and availability as not all maps are in circulation at any given time.



# TIPS & TRICKS



While it is important to remember that this is a party game where skill can be defeated by pure luck, there are a few tricks you can keep up your sleeve to give you the highest chance of success.

## Clusterfails

Groups of players are almost always bad news. The game's ragdoll physics means that one player's mishap can take down those unfortunate enough to be in their path. Players can also use the grab action to hold onto others to sabotage their game.

## Dive to stay alive

Master the art of the dive as soon as possible. This simple move can save you from certain elimination in the nick of time when used correctly. Dodge moving obstacles, avoid grabby players, get that extra bit of momentum to jump a gap, or even slide down slime hills extra fast.

## Go with the flow

When you're still new to the game, following other players on an unfamiliar map can help you avoid some of the more common pitfalls and help you navigate it faster.

## Watch and learn

If you happen to be eliminated, don't quit. Spectate another player and learn more about maps you may not know yet, or learn techniques to help you conquer levels that have been getting you down. There's always something to learn, even if it's what NOT to do.
