

# WHAT IS IT?




Star Wars: Jedi Survivor is an upcoming action-adventure game developed by Respawn Entertainment and published by Electronic Arts. It is the sequel to Star Wars Jedi: Fallen Order (2019), and it is set five years after the events of that game.

## STAR WARS JEDI SURVIVOR

The game follows Cal Kestis, a Jedi Padawan who survived Order 66. Cal is on the run from the Galactic Empire, and he is trying to find a way to rebuild the Jedi Order. He is joined by his friends Cere Junda and Greez Dritus, as they travel the galaxy in search of a new home for the Jedi. Star Wars: Jedi Survivor is an action-adventure game which means it features a variety of combat and exploration mechanics. Cal can use a lightsaber and the Force to fight enemies. While exploring he can also use a variety of gadgets and abilities to solve puzzles. The game features a large, open world where players can explore a variety of planets and locations.

# BREAKDOWN THE BASICS



Jedi Survivor sees a return of many mechanics from Fallen Order but also a host of new ones to excite both old and new players alike. Need tips to make the most of the experience? Read on. There are some core mechanics to master!

# Mechanics



## Combat

Combat in Star Wars: Jedi Survivor is similar to that of Star Wars Jedi: Fallen Order. Cal Kestis uses a lightsaber and the Force to fight a host of droids, monsters, and other enemies. Combat is flowing and does not require you to be a master of timing to enjoy performing spectacular fight sequences.

The lightsaber can be used to slash, stab, and block attacks. Cal can also use the lightsaber to perform a variety of special moves in conjunction with Force skills to make a combat style all your own. Combat revolves heavily around lightsaber stances, some of which Cal knows already and others which must be learned. Each has their strengths and weaknesses, it's up to you to decide what works best for you:

- Single Blade: Flexible, Balanced
- Dual Blades: Fastest Attacks, Move Canceling
- Double-Bladed Staff: Crowd Control, Area of Effect Damage
- Cross Guard Blade: High Damage, Guard Breaking
- Blaster and Blade: Ranged Attacks, Mix of Close and Distant Strikes



## Force

The Force is a powerful energy of the universe that Cal can control to manipulate the environment and to fight enemies. Force Abilities are essential to progressing in Jedi Survivor. Apart from making a difference in combat, they're also needed to solve puzzles and unlock areas in the game. All Force Abilities cost power which can be tracked on the Force Meter, much like mana. There are five abilities in total:

- Confuse: Control enemies and make them fight others.
- Force Pull: Pull enemies and objects towards you.
- Force Push: Push enemies and objects away from you.
- Lift and Slam: Lift enemies up into the air, then slam them into the ground.
- Slow Time: Enemies move slower, making their actions easier to predict.




## Gadgets

Your helpful companion BD-1 can perform scans on enemies once they're downed. These scans provide insights into enemies that will give an edge in combat. You'll also need to unlock the Ascension Cable. It functions as a grappling hook allowing you to ascend to new heights and reach new areas via the yellow balloons you find dispersed through the game.

## Progression

Cal Kestis can progress through the game by completing quests, defeating enemies, and finding items. As Cal progresses unlocking more skills through the skill trees and meditations, he will become stronger and more skilled. These skills can be unlocked by levelling up or by finding skill crystals. The Skill Tree (Survival, Lightsaber, Force) gives additional power ups and helps to customise your playthrough by allowing you to strengthen your favourite moves and strengthen your playstyle.



## Exploration

Exploration is key to preparing Cal for the end-game bosses and challenges. Make sure you spend time exploring every nook and cranny of the world to slake your curiosity and discover all the secrets that await you. There are various mounts to assist Cal in traversing the diverse landscape:

- Relter: A flying creature you can use to glide between cliffs.
- Nekko: A sturdy mount that allows you to climb steep terrain, perform double jumps, as well as engage in mounted combat.
- Spamel: A long-legged desert creature that handles sloped terrain and occasionally acts as a launch pad for Cal to jump to hard-to-reach positions.
- Speeder Bike: Unlocked after some progression into the game, you'll be able to use this vehicle to travel at higher speeds.




## Environment



The map includes a variety of planets and locations, including:

- Bracca: an inhospitable planet in the Mid Rim. It is home to the Scrapper Guild who salvage decommissioned ships and sell the components to the Galactic Empire.
- Nur: a dangerous, swampy planet in the Outer Rim Territories. The heavily fortified Fortress Inquisitorius is located here.
- Zeffo: this watery planet, located in an Outer Rim system, is home to an ancient Jedi temple.
- Bogano: a largely uninhabited planet that is home to a variety of creatures and plants. The Bogano Vault located here holds some very important secrets.
- Dathomir: another remote planet in the Outer Rim that is home to a powerful Nightsister coven. It has a history of a strong presence of the dark side of the Force.
- Ilum: this small, icy planet in the Unknown Regions is home to a kyber crystal cave. There is no place more sacred to the Jedi.



# TIPS & TRICKS



## Meditation Points

Always visit Meditation Points when you get the opportunity. They simultaneously act as save points, respawn points, and fast travel points. Be careful! Resting will respawn all the enemies in the area, but your health and Stims will be fully restored.

## Losing XP

When you die, you'll "drop" XP. To reclaim this XP you will need to attack the enemy that killed you. Look for the enemy with a yellow aura and when you strike it your XP will be returned to you. Your life and force meters will be topped up too!

## Light It Up

Hold the block button to use Cal's lightsaber as a lightsource to help you investigate dark areas.

## Fall Damage

Don't think you've cheated fall damage by sliding down the ledge. The height of the "fall" has already been calculated and Cal will either die or take no damage at all.



## Health Buddy

The health bar is pretty visible, but in case you miss it sneak a peak at the lights on BD-1. If your companion lights up red it means you need to heal ASAP.

## Speak Your Mind

When using Jedi Mind Tricks in dialogues throughout the game you are given a dialogue choice. This choice is merely for your pleasure and won't affect the outcome of the conversation so choose what feels best!
